

## **COVID-19-Clubhouse Mitigation Plan**

The following is the COVID-19 Mitigation Plan for the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Kenai Peninsula Clubhouse Program:

1. Anyone exhibiting the following symptoms MAY NOT enter the premises while there are ongoing Clubhouse activities. If a youth, parent, or guardian is exhibiting these symptoms, or any symptoms consistent with COVID19, the youth may not participate in the programming until the individual has been symptom free for 24 hours, or the individual has a negative COVID test and has been symptom free for 24 hours. Symptoms include:
  - a. Cough
  - b. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - c. Fever
  - d. Chills
  - e. Muscle Pain
  - f. Sore throat
  - g. New loss of taste or smell
  - h. Any additional symptoms consistent with COVID-19 as updated by the State of Alaska and the CDC.
2. All participants will be given training on COVID symptoms and how to prevent it's spread in an age appropriate way.
3. Travel-In accordance to CDC recommendations: Those individuals who are returning from travel who are vaccinated do not need to get tested or self quarantine on return. Those individuals who have had a positive COVID19 test in the previous 3 months do not need to quarantine on return. Those individuals who have not received a COVID19 vaccine, and who have not had COVID19 in the prior three months can return to work or attend the program 7 days after travel with a negative COVID test or 10 days after travel with no symptoms and with no COVID test.
4. Youth who are exhibiting symptoms will be separated from the rest of the participants and their guardian will be asked to take them home.
5. The facilities and high touch places will be cleaned often throughout the day in accordance to CDC guidance for cleaning schools and youth facilities.
6. Hand sanitizer or hand washing stations will be provided and Members and Staff will be required to wash their hands often.
7. Social distancing will be emphasized between individuals wherever possible.
8. All individuals will be tracked and an attendance sheet for each day will be kept.
9. Masks are required when indoors and youth and staff are closer than 6 feet from one another. If youth and staff are greater than 6 feet from one another while indoors they will not be required to wear a mask. Masks will not be required outside.
10. Individuals who have been exposed to COVID19 in a previous 48 hour period will be required to adhere to CDC guidance regarding quarantine and isolation.
11. Employees will receive training regarding CDC and any additional applicable requirements to mitigate the spread of COVID19.
12. Shared items in the Clubhouse will be disinfected after use, and youth will wash their hands prior to and after its use.
13. Employees will receive training regarding CDC and State of Alaska requirements to have for review and continued mitigation of the spread of COVID19.
14. Individuals who are not following the mitigation plan, or who meet criteria that would cause concern for the spread of COVID19 will be asked to leave the premises.
15. Where programming occurs in KPBSD School Facilities- the KPBSD mitigation plan, as well as this mitigation plan, is to be followed. Should a variance arise between the two mitigation plans, the stricter of the two mitigation plans will be adhered to.
